

Myhometown | The voids of the war

This itinerary begins near the house of an old headmistress of a primary school. Known affectionately as la vecchia (the old lady), she often told about her afternoon of mid August 1943 at the *sanctuary of San Celso* when **3** allied bombers dropped thousands of bombs on the city. We begin in piazzale di porta Ludovica at the patisserie Gattullo (short distance by \P tram from the yellow metro line Missori). On the front door to the right of the patisserie, the wording US and R refer to the emergency exits and air raid shelter respectively.

Beyond the small green area, in the brown tile building is where **la vecchia's house** once was. Despite the bombs, remained quite intact but was demolished after the war. Let's take corso Italia up towards via Molino dell Armi which we turn on to: the green space along via Campo 4 Lodigiano we see the partial remains of a house leaning against the adjacent building.

The bombs turned all of the buildings to rubble between here and the parco delle Basiliche.
