


Paper Caper




How to build it




Print the file. Cut the figure along the full lines and bend it on the dotted lines.




Fold it along the mid line, then put the glue on the top side.




Glue the two sides putting the top side on the bottom side.




Fold it along the right side of the sixth triangle.




Fold it along the right side of the third triangle.



Fold the top triangle (c) on the back of the hexagon.



Glue the ends of the band together.



That's the hexagon!




Place Card




Decoration

How to use it as a toy




- 1 Hold the hexagon in two hands.
- 2 Pinch two triangles together along one of the edges. Push the outer corner of the opposite two triangles inward.
- 3 Open up the opposite two triangles at the center to reveal an inner face (if they refuse to open, try pinching an adjacent pair of triangles.) Repeat.

How to use it as a decoration



- 1 Cut a small hole by the base of one of the triangles.
- 2 Put a ribbon through the hole.
- 3 Tie it on the top. Hang it.

How to use it as a place card



- 1 Push the green sides together.
- 2 Pull the blue corner.
- 3 Flatten the base to make the place card stable.
- 4 Write the name of your guests.
